

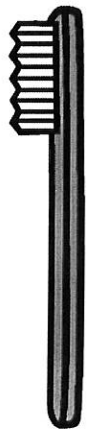

CLINIC FAQ

I don't qualify for Medicaid and can't afford other dental insurance. Do I qualify for services?

Yes. As long as you don't have other dental insurance and meet income guidelines, the SCDC will serve you. You will be charged an insurance copayment or a fee based on the services performed. This fee must be paid at the beginning of your visit.

I don't live in Story County. Can I receive services?

Yes. The SCDC was established to offer services to low-income individuals in Story County, but it has since expanded to serve residents in other counties.

Where is the clinic located?

The SCDC is located just south of Hickory Park Restaurant Co., at 226 SE 16th Street in Ames. Please use the south entrance to the building.

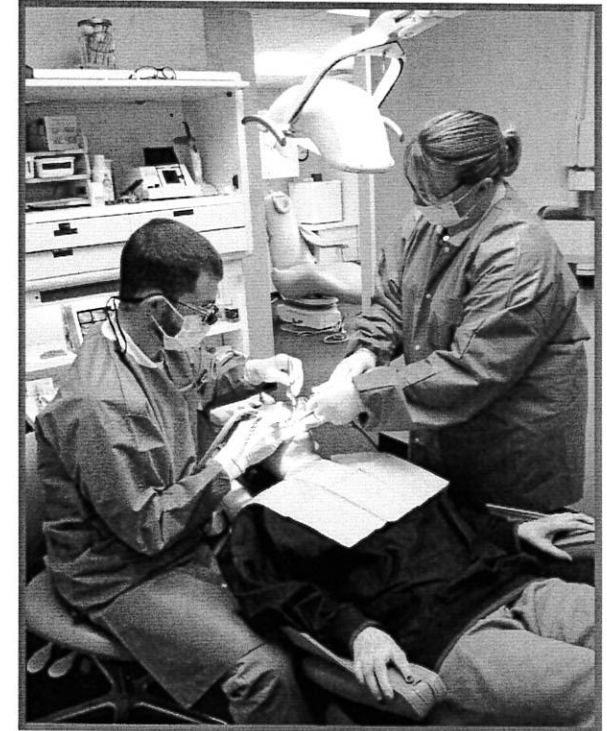

GETTING STARTED

To get started, please call the SCDC at 515-598-5298. The receptionist will help you determine whether you're eligible to receive services and will schedule your appointment.

If you're insured by Medicaid, please bring your insurance card to your first visit.

Uninsured patients need to provide proof of income, such as pay stubs or income tax records.

SERVICES



The SCDC employs a full-time staff of highly trained dental professionals.

Services include:

- Exams
- Cleanings
- X-rays
- Fillings for cavities
- Basic extractions
- Crowns
- Root canals
- Dentures

The SCDC accepts patients of all ages, from any county in Iowa.

FEES

All SCDC patients will be charged either an insurance copayment or a fee for service.

Medicaid patients are charged \$3 per office visit. Uninsured patients will be charged discounted rates.

All payments must be made in full at the time of service. Payment plans are not available.
